In 2011, he joined the German medical technology company Biotronik, where he initially assumed the role of Chief Executive Officer and President of the Vascular Interventions division in Switzerland. In 2017, he was appointed to the Executive Board of Biotronik SE & Co. KG in Berlin/Germany. He held this position until he joined Röchling Medical in July 2022.
