After completing a Bachelor's degree in business administration, Raphael Wolfram rounded off his studies with a Master's degree in finance at the University of St. Gallen, Switzerland.

From 2007 to 2012, he worked for Goldman Sachs International in Zurich and London, including as an analyst in the Securities division and lastly as head of Marketing & Sales of the Fund Solutions division for the Economic region of Europe, the Middle East, and Africa (EMEA). In 2012, Wolfram – who was born in Vienna – moved to the Greiner Group in Austria. The internationally active, family-owned company is one of the world's largest manufacturers and processors of plastic and foam. Wolfram initially worked for Greiner as head of the Corporate Center in Beijing, China, responsible for the Asian activities of the Group before taking on the role of Managing Director of Greiner Packaging in Istanbul, Turkey, in 2015. There he assumed responsibility for business development in the Near and Middle East as well as Africa.

On 1 May 2019, Wolfram joined Röchling as CFO of Röchling Automotive, and since 1 January 2021 he has also been responsible for the Asian business of the division. He was appointed CEO of Röchling Automotive as of 1 October 2021. In addition, he remained CFO until mid-April 2023. On 1 January 2022, he was appointed to the Executive Board of the Röchling Group. In this position he is responsible for the Automotive Division. He has held the position of Executive Board Spokesman of the Röchling Group since 1 June 2022. With effect from 1 February 2025, Raphael Wolfram moved to the Industrial division, where he will take over as CEO on 1 July 2025.
